SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM

The Supportive Housing Program has been designed to help create opportunities for low-income people in Lake County to become self-sufficient. This program can provide assistance with the cost of housing over a period of up to 18 months. In exchange for this housing support, customers will be expected to actively participate in programs that will assist them with money management, education and training.

Guidelines:

- Customers' income should be at or below 80% of Area Median Income guidelines.
- Customers must be residents of Lake County.
- Customers will be asked to create both long and short-term self-sufficiency goals with guidance from Lifeline's Consumer Education Coordinator. These goals will include some type of continuing education, as determined mutually.
- All customers must be willing to participate in a monthly home visit and an office appointment.
